$$\text{1. } \begin{cases} x + 3y = 5 \\ 2x - 3y = 1 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{2. } \begin{cases} 2x + y = 6 \\ 3x + 5y = 9 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{3. } \begin{cases} 3x - 7y = 10 \\ x - 4y = 5 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{4. } \begin{cases} 3x + y = 6 \\ 2x - 4y = 10 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{5. } \begin{cases} 4x + 6y = 8 \\ 3x + y = 9 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{6. } \begin{cases} x - 7y = 12 \\ 2x + 8y = 14 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{7. } \begin{cases} x - 3y = 18 \\ -x + 3y = 12 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{8. } \begin{cases} 2x + 5y = 1 \\ x + \frac{5}{2}y = \frac{1}{2} \end{cases}$$

$$\text{9. } \begin{cases} -3x + 4y = 1 \\ x = 2y + 1 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{10. } \begin{cases} 5x - 2y = 6 \\ -10x + 4y = -12 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{11. } \begin{cases} -2x + y = 8 \\ -6x + 3y = 12 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{12. } \begin{cases} 5x - 2y = -20 \\ 6x + y = -7 \end{cases}$$

$$\text{13. } \begin{cases} x - y - 12 = 0 \\ 2x + 1 = -3y \end{cases}$$
